This is a joint petition filed by Sri Jyotirmoy Deka and Smt. Pallabi Das u/s 28 of the Special Marriage Act, 1954 for a decree of dissolution of marriage on mutual consent.

It is averred in the petition that both petitioners got married on 19.09.2016 at the Office of Marriage Officer, Goalpara and lived as husband and wife at the residence of petitioner Pallabi Das at Lakhipur, Goalpara after performing all Hindu Vedic rites and rituals but they did not have any issue nor they could adjust with each other due to temperamental differences or incompatibilities and so, they decided to live separately from each other and since more than one and half years both of them have been living separately in their respective parental house. Further, their relationship has come to such a stage that it is not at all possible for them to live as husband and wife any more. Therefore, both the petitioners have mutually agreed for dissolution of their marriage. Hence, this joint petition was filed.

I have heard the learned counsels for the petitioners. Both the petitioners filed a joint examination-in-chief on affidavit and I have perused the same.

Both the petitioners have been examined for a settlement on reconciliation but in vain.

In view of the joint petition as well as on their testimony on affidavit, I find that there is no impediment in granting the decree for dissolution of marriage on mutual consent as prayed for. Hence, the petition is allowed and the marriage of the petitioner and respondent is dissolved from today by granting the decree of dissolution of marriage on mutual consent.

Draw up the decree accordingly within the prescribed period of time.

This case is thus disposed of.
